Examples of courses to use toward your advanced certificate include, but are not limited to: Critical Incident Stress Management, Pastoral Crisis Intervention, Grief, Disaster Chaplaincy, Counseling, Addictions, Chaplain Safety, Chaplain Operations, etc. Completion of the Advanced Certificate represents a considerable investment of time, energy, and dedication.
You can also get elective credit hours toward your advanced certificate from formal education and ministry experience:
Undergraduate Degree in ministry field (10 credits)
Graduate Degree (Masters, Doctorate) in ministry field (15 credits)
1-5 years experience in ministry field (5 credits)
