Thursday, March 23, 2017: Description of Class: Developing a Fire Message for a Fire Department Funeral: 8 Hrs.

This course, designed for Fire Chaplains, is an introduction to the basic components that will equip the chaplain to effectively plan a funeral/memorial service that honors fallen fire personnel and retirees, and underscores the respect, dignity, and protocol of the fire service.

It also offers helpful and practical advice on how to interact with grieving family and fire department personnel while planning a funeral. This class addresses preparation steps, key issues, conflict resolution and recommendations.

Friday, March 24, 2017: Description of Class: Compassion Fatigue (The Cost of Caring) 4 Hrs.

This class identifies the Pro-Active need of the Caregiver to care for themselves and remain stable in their own lives prior to assuming the overwhelming task of assisting to stabilizing victims and vicarious victims of traumatic events. Includes: Stress and its effect on people; Critical Incidents Hurt; Compassion Fatigue; Replenishing- It is necessary; Prescriptions for:
