Crisis management is an intense process designed to lessen the emotional stress created during crisis response. As a Peer Support Responder, we can help resolve short-time issues until professional assistance is available.

Most Fire/Rescue personnel are highly dedicated and pride themselves on doing a "perfect job," under unusually high expectations, which can cause frustration when they feel as though they failed during an incident.
